Update on February Stakeholder Meeting

This e-newsletter is designed to update all Stakeholders who were not able to attend the Stakeholder meeting on February 22 on several significant decisions that were made at the meeting:

Stakeholder Meetings in 2011-2012. BMW will continue to conduct five stakeholder meetings a year, but the April meeting may include coordination with the Greenway Foundation for their South Platte River Clean-Up Day.

Dates for the 2011 Stakeholder meetings are:

- April 23, tentative, River Clean-up event; if a Stakeholder meeting is needed in April, Stakeholders may be invited to the Technical Committee meeting on April 28. For more information about the River Clean-Up and how Stakeholders can participate, click [here](#).
- June 28, meeting followed by a Watershed Tour of Rocky Mountain Arsenal (tentative).
- August 23, meeting followed by BMW's Annual BBQ.
- October 25, tentative, either a regular meeting or a joint conference with CLRMA and other urban watershed groups.

Additional Stakeholder meetings may be convened as needed, as has been done in the past. Stakeholders are encouraged to stay involved to stay abreast of the important studies BMW will be conducting to implement the TMDL.

New E-Newsletter. The *Barrimeter* is being replaced with this new, briefer and more flexible e-newsletter that can be sent out as BMW has news to share.

New Role for the Board. The Board will assume the education and outreach responsibilities of the former I&E Committee, and *ad hoc* committees will be formed as needed. Stakeholders are encouraged to participate in these task-specific committees.
