Coming from I-25

Take the 84th Ave exit (near American Furniture Warehouse) east to Washington Street. Turn left on Washington heading north to 88th Ave. Turn right on 88th heading east to Welby Road (just past the railroad tracks), then turn right and head south to 86th Ave. Head east to Wes Brown Plant (about ½ mile). The plant is on the left.

Coming from I-76

Take the 88th Ave exit (by Mile Hi Flea Market), and head west to Welby Rd. Turn left on Welby Rd and head south to 86th Ave. Turn left, heading east, to Wes Brown Plant (about ½ mile). The plant is on the left.

Parking:

There is a large parking lot on the north (back) side of the building. Limited parking is also available in front of the plant. The front doors have a button that can be pushed to request entrance, but there will also be someone present to allow meeting participants to enter. The meeting will be in the second floor conference room.
